I recently picked up The Little Book of Bulletproof Investing. It was an easy read. I got through it in about an hour or so. For those of you familiar with Ben Stein, this is his latest collaborative work (with Phil De Muth). However, even though this is a general resource on investing and some assertions about personal finances are made, neither the Knights of Columbus nor me are responsible for its content. I just found it interesting enough to actually finish... *This book is not endorsed by either the Order of the Knights of Columbus or me.* That disclaimer made, I found the book interesting and elements helpful. One section touched on the Knights of Columbus main product line, whole life insurance. I like this response to the product, because someone other than the Knights of Columbus is trumpeting its value.

“In our previous tomes, we have sung the praises of term life insurance as the best low-cost option for many people. Let us pause here to say a few words on behalf of whole life. A whole life policy, bought with a careful eye on expenses, can be a friend in time of need.
