Respect Life Message

“Turning the Tide”

The 28-minute film features interviews with a wide array of individuals, ranging from those with physical disabilities to a palliative-care nurse consultant to Bobby Schindler, brother of Terri Schiavo.

“We have a responsibility to confront this action, especially if we are to understand our moral obligation as caregivers for incapacitated persons, and our civic obligation to protect those who lack the capacity to express their will,” said Father Rosica. “There can be no true peace unless life is defended and promoted.”

It is to this end that the Euthanasia Prevention Coalition has operated since its inception. Alex Schadenberg, grand knight of Rev. John McMaster Council 6495 in West Lorne, Ont., serves as director of the EPC and was the Ontario State Council pro-life chairman from 1995-96. He decided to create Turning the Tide after meeting Father Rosica at a Catholic men’s conference.

“My whole purpose was to create something that affects you emotionally and intellectually,” Schadenberg said. “The message is, in the end, that we have to care for the other person. It’s about the individual and how they live their life.”

Schadenberg is optimistic that Knights will find the film extremely useful. “[The video] is designed so that anybody can show this to any group of people and, with the study guide, make a very effective presentation on euthanasia and assisted suicide,” he said. “The Knights need to know that we can effectively deal with this issue.”

Chaplain's Message

Some Thoughts from our Supreme Chaplain Bishop William E. Lori

You may have read about a document issued in June by the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith. "Responses to Some Questions Regarding Certain Aspects of the Doctrine on the Church" reiterated the Church's teaching authority. Although this brief document merely summarized a number of previous teachings, particularly those of the Second Vatican Council, it created something of a stir. This was because it reminded us of a central truth about the Catholic Church that is sometimes forgotten or distorted, namely, that "the Church of Christ subsists in the Catholic Church." This means that Christ permanently willed to establish only one Church, as a visible and spiritual community, and that the fullness of what Christ willed is found only in the Catholic Church.

This Vatican document further taught that Christ endowed the Catholic Church with all the means of salvation which he himself communicated and instituted during his mission on earth, in accordance with the Father's plan of salvation. This includes God's Word in its fullness transmitted to us through Scripture and tradition. It also includes access, through the sacraments, to all Jesus said and did for our salvation. This also includes the presence and action of the Holy Spirit as the invisible but very real principle of the Church's life and mission. To put it succinctly, Christ willed that the one, true Church would live on in the Catholic Church.

This is only an excerpt from his article in the September Columbia Magazine. Please take time to read the entire article. It is to be a very important series on what the Church teaches and what we as Catholics should believe, because it is from Jesus Christ Himself.
